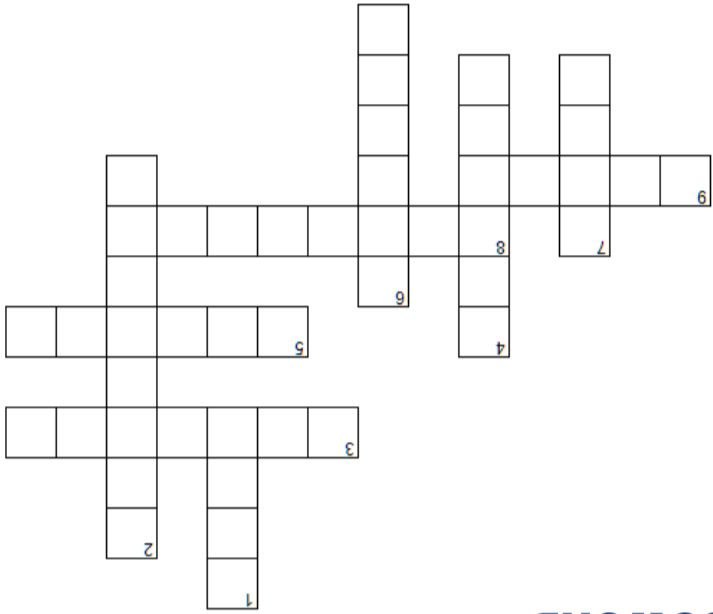


Can you solve the clues to find the words that complete the grid about what we have been learning about today? I wonder how you would have felt if you had been there with Mary all those years ago...?

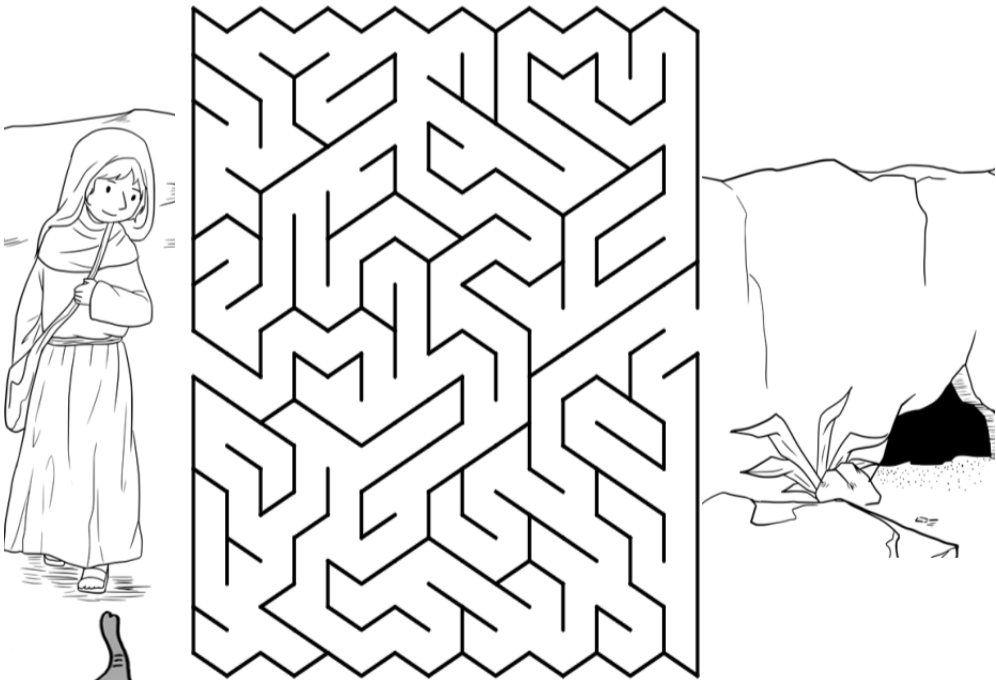

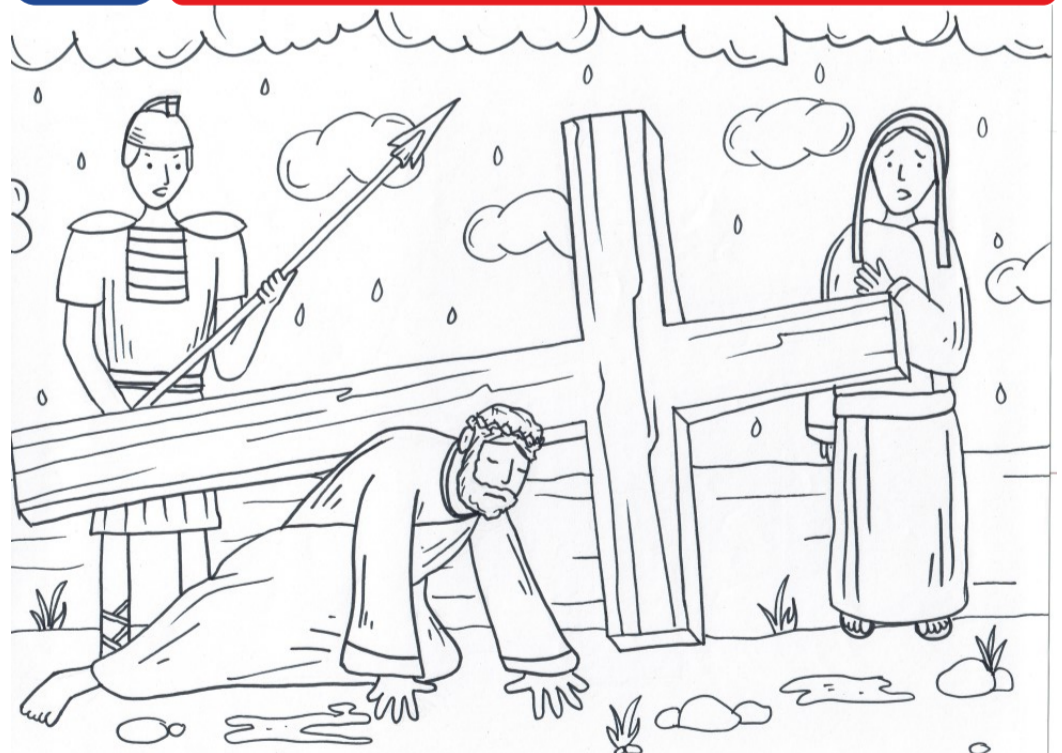

HE IS ALIVE

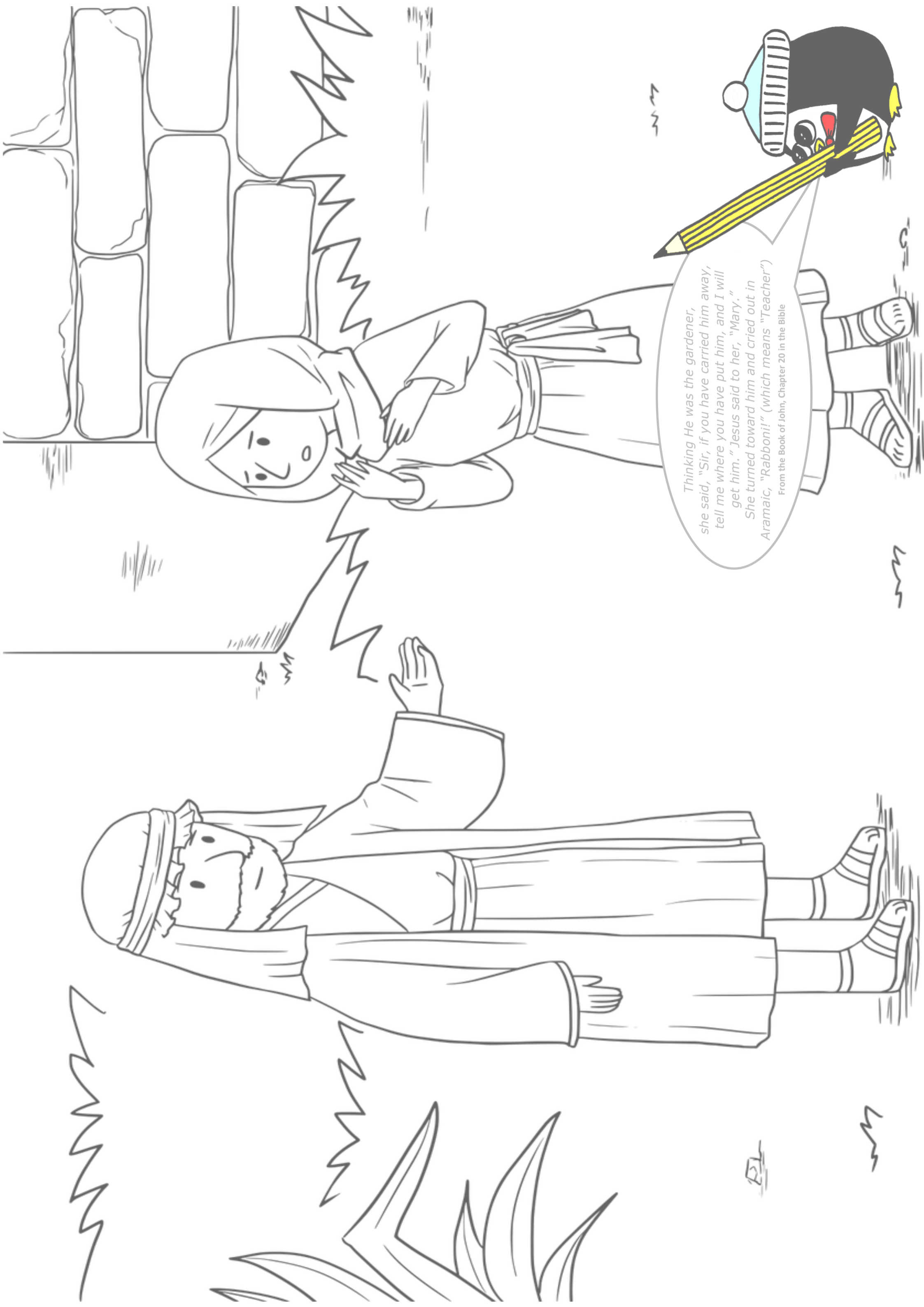
John 20: The Resurrection
