




1. DRAW YOUR DESIGN USING A PENCIL AND PAPER



5. PLACE STENCIL ON THE FRONT OF THE T-SHIRT



8. USE YOUR PAINT BRUSH TO DRIZZLE BLEACH AROUND THE T-SHIRT



11. CUT THE STITCHED HEM OFF THE BOTTOM






2. CUT OUT THE DESIGN WITH A CUTTING KNIFE OR SCISSORS. DON'T FORGET TO PUT A MATT UNDERNEATH TO PROTECT YOUR SURFACE



6. WEARING RUBBER GLOVES AND USING A SPONGE DAB THE INSIDE OF THE STENCIL WITH BLEACH. DON'T FORGET TO PUT SOMETHING IN BETWEEN THE T-SHIRT TO STOP THE BLEACH SOAKING THROUGH TO THE BACK




9. DRIZZLE BLEACH ACROSS SLEEVES AS WELL



12. CUT OUT THE STITCHED NECK LINE



4. YOUR FINISHED STENCIL SHOULD LOOK SOMETHING LIKE THIS



7. THE MORE BLEACH YOU USE THE STRONGER THE DESIGN. THE EDGES OF THE DESIGN ARE LIKELY TO BLEED

13. CUT THE SELVEDGE OFF BOTH SLEEVES
